Dear Parent:

A well-rounded education provides for a variety of experiences both in and outside the classroom. The classroom academic work should be enriched and supplemented in many ways. An educational field trip represents active learning for the individual student and is considered an extension of the classroom. Such field trips are scheduled by all elementary schools throughout the school year.

Parental permission is needed in order that your child may participate in the scheduled field trips. Please complete and sign the Field Trip Permission Slip that is found at the bottom of this sheet. The permission slip will be placed on file at the school thereby eliminating the necessity for permission slips for each field trip.

The following procedures will be used for all field trips:

1. You will be notified of the place and time of any field trip. If you do not want your child to go on that trip, you should notify the school.
2. The regular classroom teacher will accompany the class on the trip. In some instances parents are asked to volunteer as additional chaperones.
3. School district funds are not available to provide transportation for field trips. These expenses are met through donations or the charging of a fee to the individual student. You will be notified in the event a fee is required to cover the cost of transportation for a particular field trip.
